Dear Parents and Carers,

Once again, it is with great pleasure that I am able to provide details of Wapping High School's Easter Revision sessions that will be delivered over the holidays.

Like last year, our dedicated staff will be giving up some of their well-earned holiday in order to come into school and provide targeted intervention and/or revision sessions for all Year 11 students (see attached document). As there are now only four teaching weeks left before the exam season is officially upon us, I highly recommend that you support us in ensuring that your child attends the sessions applicable for him/her.

Not all revision sessions will be applicable for all students and your child should - with consultation with both their teacher(s) and at home - decide which ones are best for them i.e. where there may well be gaps in their knowledge. However, while not every session may be relevant for your child they should be aiming to complete at least six hours of revision per day over the holiday, whether this be in school or at home.

When in school over Easter, it is important to note that no lunch will be provided - with it being out of term time - and students must leave the site when teachers are not running a session between 13:15 and 14:00. Upon entering and leaving school, all students and staff will be expected to sign in and out in the interests of health and safety.

The Science Department are unable to offer any Easter sessions but remind pupils that considerable revision support and resources are available in the following places:
