Dear Parent/Carers,

Summer Term: Girls Fencing

We would like to invite your child to take part in a Girls' Fencing Project which is being delivered by external, qualified coaches from an organisation called Maslaha. This project couples fencing sessions with creative workshops that explore themes around stereotypes, identity and self-expression, and teach skills in advocacy.

The workshops aim to challenge stereotypes of women by presenting alternative visions of what it is to be a young woman in the UK today. In the pilot series of this project in East London, a photography series and short film were produced and featured at the Southbank Centre as part of the Women of the World (WOW) festival 2016.

While the project is focused on tackling misconceptions of Muslim girls, we would like non-Muslim girls to participate also and the project is open to students of all backgrounds. The initiative also aims to break down conceptions of fencing as an elite sport that is not accessible to young people of all backgrounds.

The project will take place for ten weeks of fencing sessions alongside creative workshops all taking place on the school premises. Maslaha also supports participants through the Ambassador Scheme, where girls can act as advocates for the project at events and in the media, and build their communication skills— for example, public-speaking, media work, advocacy, mentoring and volunteering.

There are limited spaces on this programme so it is vital you make sure your child is committed to the project and attends every week of the project.
