Physical Education: Academic Year 2020


I am writing to inform you of how sport and PE lessons will take place in September 2020 in light of the COVID-19 pandemic and current government guidelines. It is Wapping High School's priority to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all students and staff and the PE department will be working hard to make sure that is the case during PE lessons.

The PE department has carried out a specific COVID-19 risk assessment and it has been shared with all relevant staff members. To reassure you as parents/carers and students that staff will be taking all necessary precautions please see the main points below;

- Students should attend school already dressed in their PE kits on the days they have PE/ sport.
- Students will not be required to get changed after PE lessons to reduce the amount of time they are in the changing rooms.
- Students will be required to drop off their belongings in the changing rooms and leave promptly.
- Students will be asked to sanitise their hands at the start and end of each PE lesson.
- Staff will plan lessons that limit the interactions between students and allow students to remain 1m apart e.g. no contact sports.
- When going off-site for PE lessons/ sport students will walk 1m apart on the pavement.
- When using off-site facilities students will be required to sanitise their hands on entry and exit of the facility and follow the venue's protocols.
- All PE equipment will be sanitised before and after use (between lessons).
